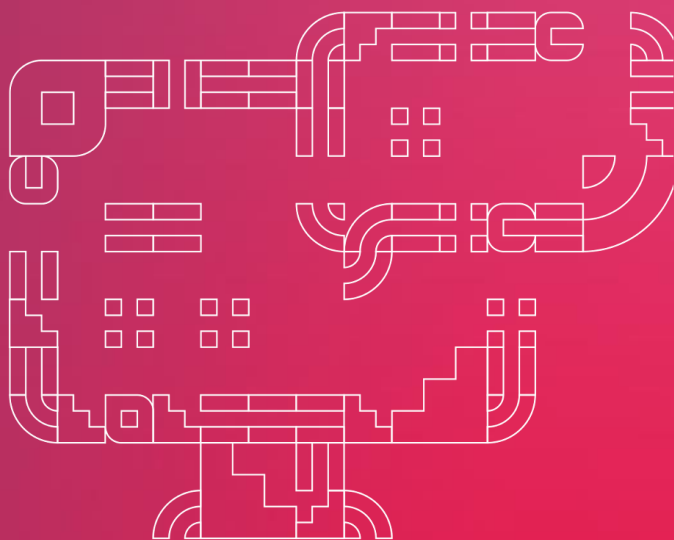

Introduction

Dear user!

This document handles the procedure of preliminary configuration of your Mac for using the F.Business Internet banking service for enterprise clients.



Please note that prior to [installing Java](#) and adjusting browser settings you need you need to install the Faktura.ru utility [for your Mac OS](#).

If you plan to use the Internet banking service for enterprise clients by logging in only with a login and a password, you do not have to install any additional utilities.

The Internet banking service will be running stable when accessed via Google Chrome (v. 70.0 and newer) web browser on Mac OS 10.14 (Mojave), 10.15 (Catalina) or 11 (Big Sur).

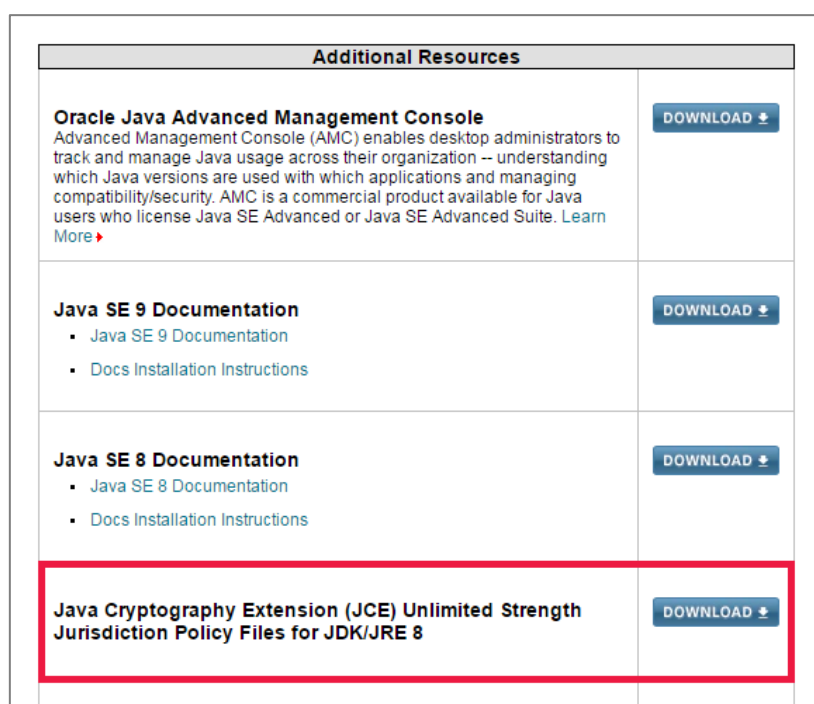
Please note that depending on the version the interface of your web browser might slightly differ from those presented in this manual.


Installing Java and its extensions

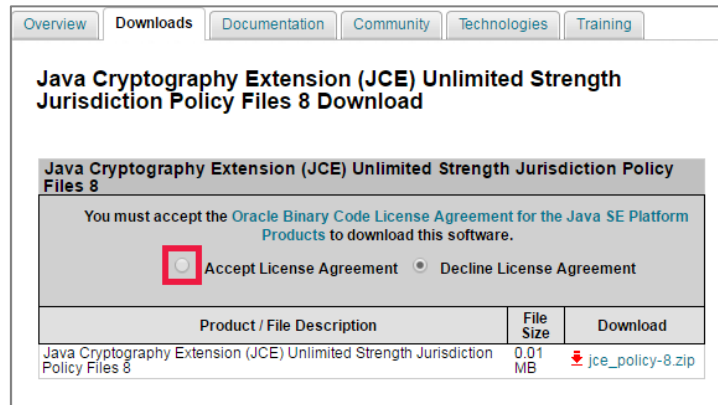
Prior to first using the Internet banking service, you need to install [Java 8](#) and [Java for OS X 2015-001](#).

Also, if you are planning to set a 7 character or longer password for your certificate, you need to install one more Java extension - Java Cryptography Extension (JCE) Unlimited Strength Jurisdiction Policy Files for JDK/JRE 8. To install the JCE please follow these steps:

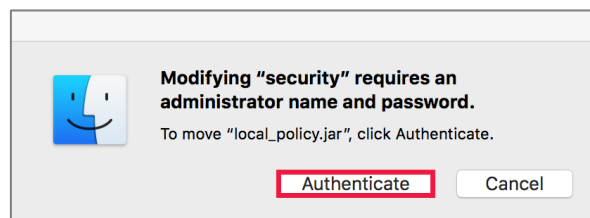
1. Go to the [Oracle Java SE](#) page.
2. At the bottom of the page in the «Additional Resources» section, find «Java Cryptography Extension (JCE) Unlimited Strength Jurisdiction Policy Files for JDK/JRE 8» and click the «Download» button.



3. The utility page will open. Agree with the terms and conditions by clicking the «Accept License Agreement» radio button and then click the  icon to download the installation file jce_policy-8.zip.



4. Unarchive the file on your Mac.
5. Replace files already existing on your Mac with the files from the downloaded archive. In order to do so:
 - a) In the Finder menu, select boot volume called Macintosh HD.
 - b) Go to «Libraries» → «Internet plug-ins» → «JavaAppletPlugin.plugin».
 - c) Click the right mouse button or use a secondary click on trackpad and select «Show package content».
 - d) Go to «Contents» → «Home» → «lib» → «security».
 - e) Copy files **local_policy.jar** and **US_export_policy.jar** from the downloaded archive into the «security» folder:
 - i. Click the «Authenticate» button.



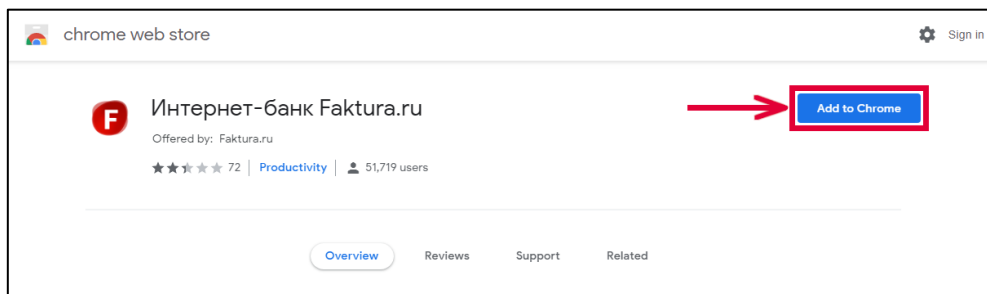
- ii. Indicate name and password of the administrator.
 - iii. Click «Replace» the pop-up window.
5. Restart your Mac.

Google Chrome web browser

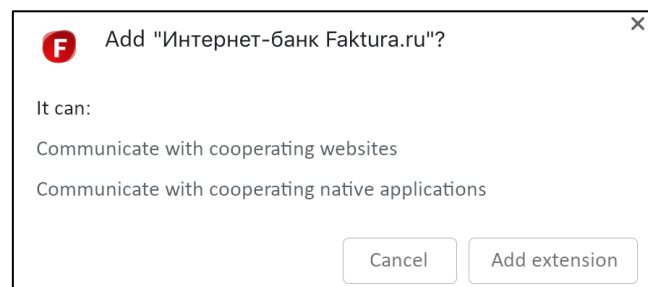
To configure Google Chrome (v. 70.0 and newer):

1. Install [the Google Chrome extension](#)

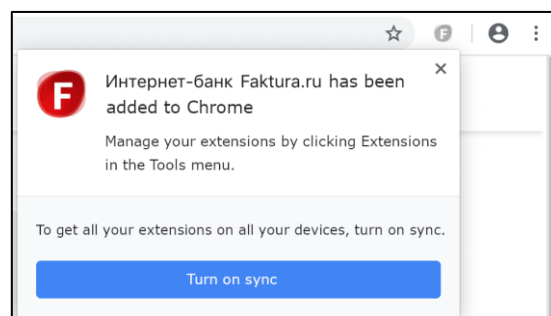
a) Click «Add to Chrome» on the extension page



b) Click «Add extension» in the pop up window



The extension will be added to Google Chrome.



2. Restart Chrome. Now you can log into the Internet banking service.

Proxy server settings

If you plan to use proxy to access the Internet banking service please perform the following steps:

1. In the «System preferences», select Java.
2. On the «General» tab, click «Network Settings...».
3. Select «Use proxy server» and input the address and port. If you need to configure advanced settings, click the «Advanced» button.
4. Click «OK» to save the changes in the Network settings window and click «OK» in the Java main window.
